2021-2022 Fort Campbell Hunting & Fishing Regulations

WHITE-TAILED DEER HUNTING**SEASON DATES & BAG LIMIT**

25 September 2021 – 2 January 2022

Only one (1) antlered deer per season. Antler measurements must meet definition of legal antlered deer. Three (3) antlerless deer per day; no season limit. Definition of antlerless deer are considered deer with less than 3 inches antler length.

Deer harvested on Fort Campbell are considered bonus for Tennessee and Kentucky license holders and do not count towards state bag limits.

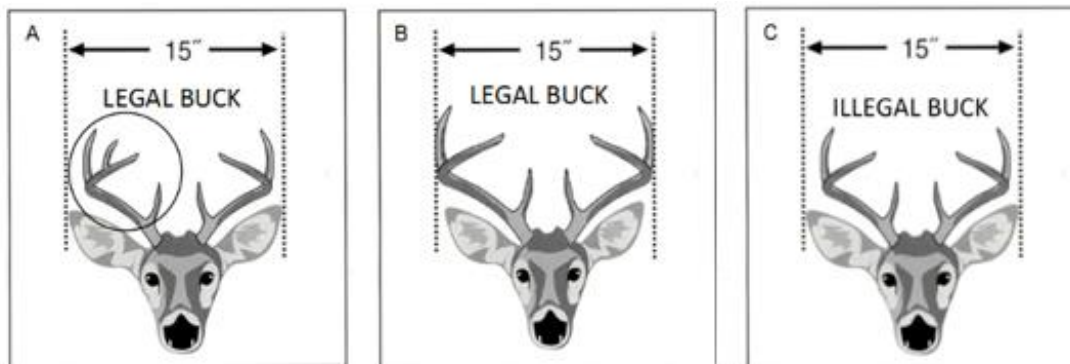
LEGAL ANTLERED DEER DEFINITION

A legal antlered deer is defined as having four (4) points on one antler or an outside spread of fifteen (15) inches. A point must be at least one (1) inch to count towards required four (4) points on one side.

An antlered deer with less than a fifteen (15) inch outside spread may be harvested if that deer has at least four (4) points on one antler.

An antlered deer with less than four (4) points on both antlers may be harvested if that deer has an outside spread of at least fifteen (15) inches.

An antlered deer with a fifteen (15) inch spread will extend just outside each ear.

**LEGAL FORMS OF TAKE**

Archery, Shotgun, Muzzleloader

Crossbows are permitted. Archery equipment is authorized in shotgun/ muzzleloader areas. Archery hunters in shotgun/muzzleloader areas must abide by hunter orange requirements. Shotguns and muzzleloaders are prohibited in archery only areas.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All harvested deer must be reported on iSportsman. Specific days may be designated where check-in is required in person for data collection. Schedule is TBD.

YOUTH DEER HUNT

SEASON DATES & BAG LIMIT

27 – 28 November 2021 (Revised 8/26/2021)

Only one (1) antlered deer may be harvested during Youth Deer Hunt. Antler restrictions do not apply for youth hunters participating in the Youth Deer Hunt. Only three (3) antlerless deer may be harvested per day during Youth Deer Hunt. Legal antlered deer for Youth Deer Hunt are considered deer with at least 3 inches antler length.

Deer harvested by youth during the Youth Deer Hunt do not count towards their Fort Campbell season bag limit.

SIGN-UPS

Youth deer hunt sign-ups will begin 15 September 2021. Youth 9 – 17 years of age, at the time of the hunt, are eligible for participation. Priority will be given to active duty military. All youth must be accompanied by an adult (one youth per one adult companion). Both youth hunters and adult companions must possess appropriate Tennessee or Kentucky issued hunting license, proof of a state certified hunter education course completion, and Fort Campbell permits at the time of registration.

CHECK STATION

All harvested deer must be checked in with Fort Campbell Fish and Wildlife. Official check-in will be conducted at Lake Kyle.



2021-2022 Fort Campbell Hunting & Fishing Regulations

WILD TURKEY HUNTING**FALL TURKEY SEASON (Harvest is limited to fall turkey areas only)**

25 September 2021 – 29 October 2021 and 1 November 2021 – 5 November 2021

(Archery only, including crossbows)

16 October 2021 – 29 October 2021

(Archery, including crossbows, and shotgun permitted)

Season limit is one (1) bearded turkey during the Fall Turkey Hunting Season.

Take of turkeys outside of areas designated for fall turkey hunting is prohibited.

SPRING TURKEY SEASON

2 April 2022 – 15 May 2022

Season limit is two (2) bearded turkeys. Daily bag limit is one (1) bearded turkey. Bearded turkeys are considered turkeys with a visible beard.

SPRING TURKEY YOUTH HUNT

19 April 2022

Youth turkey hunt sign-ups will begin 1 March 2022. All Youth must be accompanied by an adult (one youth per one adult companion). Both youth hunters and adult companions must possess appropriate Tennessee or Kentucky issued hunting licenses, proof of a state certified hunter education course completion, and Fort Campbell permits. Turkeys harvested by Youth during Youth Turkey Hunt do not count towards their Fort Campbell season bag limit. Only one (1) bearded turkey may be harvested per youth during Youth Turkey Hunt. Bearded turkeys are considered turkeys with a visible beard.

All harvested turkey must be reported to Fort Campbell Fish and Wildlife through iSportsman. Specific days may be designated where check-in is required in person for data collection. Schedule is TBD.

2021-2022 Fort Campbell Hunting & Fishing Regulations

SMALL GAME HUNTING**FALL SQUIRREL**

28 August 2021– 28 February 2022

Daily bag limit is 10.

SPRING SQUIRREL

8 May 2022 – 13 June 2022

Daily bag limit is 10

COYOTE

5 September 2021 – 14 March 2022

17 May 2022 – 6 June 2022

No daily limit. No season limit. Coyotes may be taken with shotgun, muzzleloader, rim fire rifles, or archery. Shot size greater than 00 buck is prohibited. Coyotes may be taken on any authorized hunt, except raccoon hunts. Use of electronic and non-electronic calls to lure coyotes are permitted only in designated coyote hunting areas. Coyotes may not be hunted at night.

RACCOON

17 September 2021 – 28 February 2022

Daily bag limit is 5. Hunting parties can consist of three hunters. Raccoons may be harvested during any small game hunt within defined season dates and bag limits. Opossum may be taken during any authorized raccoon hunt. No daily bag limit for Opossum.

RABBIT

6 November 2021 – 28 February 2022

Daily bag limit is 5. Hunting parties can consist of up to 4 hunters.

BOBCAT

19 November 2021 – 28 February 2022

Daily bag limit is one (1). Bobcats may be harvested on any authorized deer, or coyote hunt within defined season dates and bag limits. Use of electronic and non- electronic calls to lure bobcats are permitted in areas designated as coyote hunting areas. Harvested bobcats must be checked in on iSportsman.

QUAIL

3 January 2021 – 28 February 2022 (season length subject to abbreviation) Revised 8/26/21.

Daily bag limit is 6. Party limit is 12. Hunting parties can consist of three hunters but combined daily bag limit is restricted to 12 per party. Harvest of quail outside of an area designated for quail hunting is prohibited.

BULLFROG

1 June 2022 – 21 August 2022

Daily bag limit is 15.

2021-2022 Fort Campbell Hunting & Fishing Regulations

MIGRATORY BIRD HUNTING

Tennessee, Kentucky, and Federal laws regarding daily bag limits and possession limits apply to all migratory birds, except Canada geese which are further restricted to a daily limit of two (2).

DOVE

2 September – 28 September 2021

9 October – 31 October 2021

8 December 2021 – 15 January 2022

The daily bag limit is fifteen (15).

EARLY DUCK SEASON

Wood Duck and Teal Only

11 September – 15 September 2021

The daily bag limit of ducks is 6 and may include no more than 2 wood ducks.

Teal Only

September – 19 September 2021

The daily bag limit of ducks is 6.

EARLY CANADA GOOSE SEASON

11 September – 19 September 2021

Daily bag limit is two (2) Canada geese.

WILSON SNIPE

14 November 2021 – 28 February 2022

May be harvested (within season dates) in any small game hunting area. Daily bag limit is eight (8).

AMERICAN WOODCOCK

13 November – 5 December 2021

10 January – 31 January 2022

Daily bag limit is three (3). May be harvested (within season dates) in any small game or authorized quail hunting area.

CROW

Follows Tennessee's Statewide Hunting Season.

May be harvested (within season dates) in any small game hunting area.

LATE WATERFOWL SEASON

27 – 28 November 2021

4 December 2021 – 30 January 2022

Ducks: The daily bag limit of ducks is 6 birds/day which may include no more than 4 mallards (no more than 2 of which may be a female), 3 wood ducks, 2 canvasbacks, 2 redheads, 2 black ducks, 1 pintail, and 1 mottled duck. The daily bag limit for scaups is 1 scaup Nov. 27 and Nov. 28, Dec. 4 – Dec 16 in the Statewide Zone then 2 scaups from Dec 17 – Jan 30 in all zones.

Mergansers: 5 (only 2 of which may be hooded mergansers)

Coot: Daily bag limit is fifteen (15).

Canada geese: Daily bag limit is two (2).

The possession limit is three (3) times the daily bag limit, except on opening day and the second day of the season when the possession limit is one (1) and two (2) times the daily bag limit, respectively.

LATE WATERFOWL YOUTH HUNT

5 February 2022 and 12 February 2022

Daily bag limit for Canada geese is restricted to two (2) per day.

*Only youth hunter 9 – 16 years of age may harvest coots, gallinules, moorhens, ducks, mergansers, and geese during Youth Waterfowl Season. Youth aged 16 are still required to possess a valid Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp (Federal Duck Stamp). Non-hunting adults 21 years of age shall accompany the youth hunter(s) into the field during the Youth Waterfowl Season and must remain in a position to take immediate control of the hunting device. Up to three (3) youth hunters may be accompanied by a single qualifying adult. Both youth hunter(s) and accompanying adults must possess appropriate Tennessee and Kentucky State issued hunting licenses and Fort Campbell permit.

Waterfowl hunters are authorized to hunt in parties of four (4) persons. All hunters must be checked into the area they are hunting on the Fort Campbell iSportsman portal. Youth hunters can be checked in as guests by the party leader. However, all guests must check-out individually from their account after completion of the hunt. A valid iSportsman vehicle permit should be displayed visibly on the dashboard of all parked vehicles while hunting.

VETERANS AND ACTIVE MILITARY PERSONNEL

6 February and 13 February 2022

Daily bag limit for Canada geese is restricted to two (2) per day.

Veterans (as defined in section 101 of title 38, United States Code) and members of the Armed Forces on active duty, including members of the National Guard and Reserves on active duty (other than for training), may participate and harvest coot, gallinule, moorhen, ducks, mergansers, and geese.

Slot Limit for Black Bass: Black bass under 15" may be harvested with a daily limit of 5. Only one black bass over 15" may be harvested per day.
