MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Policy Guidance for iSportsman Hunting Validation Status of Dependents.

1. Reference. CAM Regulation 200-4 Installation Hunting and Fishing, July 2020.
2. Purpose. To clarify policy for the validation status of dependents hunting and fishing on Fort Campbell Army Reservation.
3. Applicability. This policy applies to all individuals hunting and fishing on Fort Campbell Army Reservation to include their dependents.
4. Policy. All dependents will receive same iSportsman validation status as the sponsoring parent or guardian. Individuals will be entitled to all of the hunting rights and privileges associated with their status per CAM Regulation 200-4 and iSportsman. Validation statuses will be classified in the following categories and receive the designated allotment of available hunting slots for deer and turkey seasons:
 - a. Active Duty - 55% of hunting slots.
 - b. DoD Civilians and Disabled Veterans - 30% of hunting slots.
 - c. Non-affiliated Civilians - 15% of hunting slots.
